### **The activities:**

### Enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in every home

#### 1. General Purpose of the enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Through this mission, we are not looking to add another devotion to the many already existing but we would like to transform the whole society beginning from its very basis, from its basic cell. Fr Mateo reminds us what had happened in Gethsemane on Holy Thursday: "He was still speaking when Judas, one of the Twelve, appeared, and with him a large number of men armed with swords and clubs, sent by the chief priests and the elders of the people... Knowing everything that was going to happen to him, Jesus came forward and said, 'Who are you looking for?' They answered 'Jesus, the Nazarene' He said, 'I am he'... When Jesus said, 'I am he', they move back and fell to the ground" The same happen in our days: Satan taught that families already belong to him, that he had conquered already the ramshackle homes, beaten homes furiously; but when he approached the gates of heaven to ask for the keys of families and homes, he found that the Master was there already, taking care of Nazareth; the Lord, the King of Love, the wellspring of life... Jesus was talking with the families and telling them: 'Allow me to enter into the privacy of your homes. I am the Life'; and the homes were telling Him: 'Come inside our house oh Lord; come as a King, stay with us!'

To be able to get fully into the topic, we can say that the enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in homes is such an important practice of piety that, being made seriously, can regenerate the whole world.

This is understandable: the family is the first of the natural societies, and also the most important, from different points of view. Other institutions in varied fields of the society, even the supreme one that is the State, are born from the families.

Family will be able to transmit its healthiness to the rest of institutions if it were morally healthy. But if it were contaminated by any vice, it will infect all other institutions coming from it.

Then the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in homes has as its objective to reclaim, to preserve and to perfect the basic cell of the society: the family.
