SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

St. Jean-Marie Vianney, a French priest famous for converting countless souls to Christ in his parish of Ars in the 19th century, once said "when we feel the love of God growing cold, let us instantly make a Spiritual Communion. When we cannot go to the church, let us turn towards the tabernacle; no wall can shut us out from the good God." We can indeed be grateful for that!

Spiritual communion is a prayer of desire to receive the communion when we cannot. We can do this prayer as many times during the day and at any place. Here is two forms of this prayer:

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there, and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

or

Oh Jesus, I turn toward the holy tabernacle where You live hidden for love of me. I love you, O my God. I cannot receive you in Holy Communion. Come, nevertheless, and visit me

*with Your grace. Come spiritually into my heart.
Purify it. Sanctify it. Render it like unto Your own.
Amen.*
