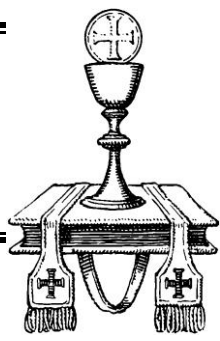

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends,
This week I would like to consider the different Liturgical Seasons (Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter, Ordinary Time, etc.). Just as the earth, because of its orbit around the Sun and the rotation of its axis has many different seasons (Summer, Fall, Spring and Winter); the Liturgy of the Church must have different seasons because of her orbit around the different Mysteries of Jesus Christ.
The different liturgical season within the Church allows us to profoundly consider and work on different virtues. When we enter the Season of Advent we grow in an expectation of Christ (Virtue of Hope) – And how must have it felt to wait the Messiah? And when we enter the season of Easter, the more we consider the joy of our redemption.
Now, we currently find ourselves in Ordinary Time – which is in fact is far from ordinary. It is in this particular season we must grow in that intimacy and friendship with Christ (that accompaniment with Christ) that allows us to live more vividly the other Liturgical Season. The closer we are to Christ, the more we will sorrow in His passion and the more we will rejoice in His resurrection.

GOSPEL of Sunday September 12 Mark 8.27-35

Jesus went on with his disciples to the villages of Caesarea Philippi; and on the way he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" And they answered him, "John the Baptist; and others, Elijah; and still others, one of the Prophets."

Jesus asked them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter answered him, "You are the Christ." And he sternly ordered them not to tell anyone about him.

Then he began to teach them that the Son of Man must undergo great suffering, and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again. He said all this quite openly.

And Peter took Jesus aside and began to rebuke him. But turning and looking at his disciples, he rebuked Peter and said, "Get behind me, Satan! For you are thinking not as God does, but as humans do."

Jesus called the crowd with his disciples, and said to them, "Whoever wants to become my follower, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, and whoever loses their life for my sake, and for the sake of the Gospel, will save it."
