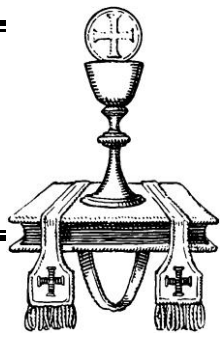

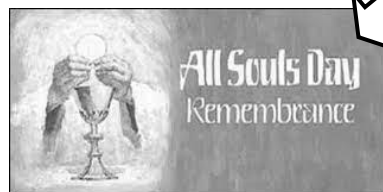

Today we consider World Mission Sunday. At initiative from Pope Pius XI in 1926, the second to last Sunday of October was named 'World Mission Sunday.' The funds collected assist some 1,250 mission dioceses under the responsibility of the Congregation for the Evangelization of People. As had been agreed by the Holy See and the Bishops of Canada a portion of the Canadian contributions to this collection will continue to assist the cause for evangelization in the Northern Canadian Dioceses.

All are encouraged and invited in any way the best can, whether it be through prayer (praying for missionary vocations or praying for the fruits of missionary work) or whether it be through material support (economically or in providing supplies). Any support for the sack of promoting the Gospel, for which our Lord gave up His life, is always appreciated as it is taking upon ourselves the spirit of the last command we read from, the Gospel of Matthew, "...go therefore and make disciples of all nations."

GOSPEL Mark 10.46-52 of Sunday October 24

As Jesus and his disciples and a large crowd were leaving Jericho, Bartimaeus son of Timaeus, a blind beggar, was sitting by the roadside. When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout out and say, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" Many sternly ordered him to be quiet, but he cried out even more loudly, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" Jesus stood still and said, "Call him here." And they called the blind man, saying to him, "Take heart; get up, he is calling you." So throwing off his cloak, he sprang up and came to Jesus. Then Jesus said to him, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man said to him, "My teacher, let me see again." Jesus said to him, "Go; your faith has made you well." Immediately the man regained his sight and followed Jesus on the way.
