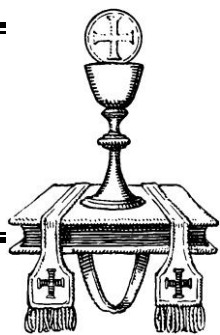

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

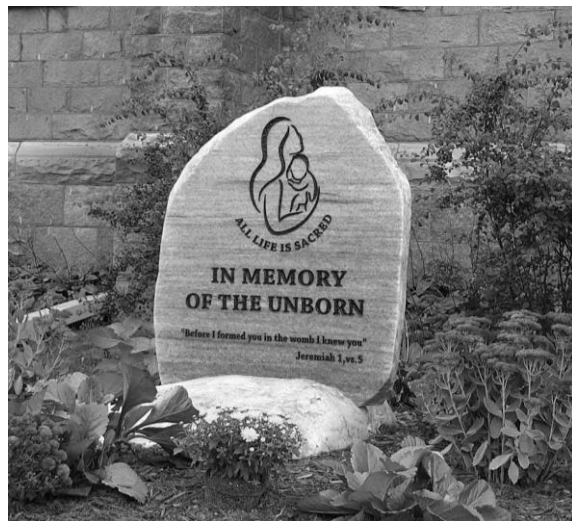
Dear Friends,

This weekend - depending on when your reading this - we are having the ProLife monument (between the Sacred Heart Church and the Rectory) blessed. Despite the monument not being so visible, I have notice it has caught the attention of many neighbors who often walk by, some of them have even taken their photo in front of it.

Now, I cannot take the credit for erecting it, as it was a work that was started by Fr. Salvador along with some generous parishioners. It truly has become a reminder to pray for and appreciate life.

We can say this monument help us keep faithful to three types of prayers: (1) to prayer for those souls that were not brought into physical birth, (2) for the conversion of those souls that have committed abortion (or are against life). (3) And lastly, a prayer of thanksgiving to God for our own life. In some cases, when there is a greater sense of appreciation for the third (for our own life), this can move us to be faithful and perseverant in prayer for the first two causes. Despite we do not see the fruits of our prayer, we are assured that God does hear our prayer, as the apostle John says, "we have this confidence in him, that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us." (1 John 5:14) I am looking forward to blessing the monument this weekend.

GOSPEL Mark 10.2-12 (shorter) of Sunday Oct. 3

Some Pharisees came, and to test Jesus they asked, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife?" Jesus answered them, "What did Moses command you?" They said, "Moses allowed a man to write a certificate of dismissal and to divorce her."

But Jesus said to them, "Because of your hardness of heart he wrote this commandment for you. But from the beginning of creation, 'God made them male and female.' 'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.' So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate."

Then in the house the disciples asked him again about this matter. Jesus said to them, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her; and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery."
