## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends,

This upcoming Friday the Church celebrates “the Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major” one of four major basilicas in Rome. The others three being: Saint Peter, Saint Paul outside the Walls and Saint John Laterano.

Traditions says, that during the time of Pope Liberius a man named John and his wife, who were without heir, wanted to make a donation of their possessions to the Virgin Mary. So, they prayed to Mary so that she may make known to them how they were to dispose of their property in her honor.

Then one day, on August 5th 352 in the middle of the Roman summer, snow fell during the night on the summit of Esquiline Hill. That same night John and his wife also had a vision of the Blessed Virgin, indicating to them to build a basilica in her honor on the very spot where the snow fell. Thus, they donated the land and sought out the construction of the Basilica Mary Major

Through this miracle we also receive the devotion to Our Lady of the Snow – as it was Our Lady through the snow that indicated where she wanted her basilica to be built.

Among the most notable relics found in the Basilica is the manger (crib) of our Lord Jesus. The manger is concealed in a transparent box for veneration underneath the Main Altar.

A second relic is a painting of the Blessed Virgin Mary under the title of ‘Salus Populi Romani’ (The Salvation of the Roman People). Tradition attributes this painting (along with the painting of our Lady of Czestochowa) to Saint Luke – the author of the Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles. This image was brought back from the Holy Land by Saint Helen, the mother of Emperor Constantine.

### Holy communion to homebound

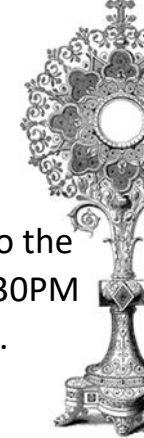

## GOSPEL Luke 12.13-21 of Sunday July 31

Someone in the crowd said to Jesus, “Teacher, tell my brother to divide the family inheritance with me.” But Jesus said to him, “Friend, who set me to be a judge or arbitrator over you?”

And Jesus said to the crowd, “Take care! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; for one’s life does not consist in the abundance of possessions.”

Then Jesus told them a parable: “The land of a rich man produced abundantly. And he thought to himself, ‘What should I do, for I have no place to store my crops?’ Then he said, ‘I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. And I will say to my soul, “Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry.”’



“But God said to him, ‘You fool! This very night your life is being demanded of you. And the things you have prepared, whose will they be?’ So it is with those who store up treasures for themselves but are not rich toward God.”

## Catechism Word Corner

**Vocation:** The calling or destiny we have in this life and hereafter. God has created the human person to love and serve him; the fulfillment of this vocation is eternal happiness (CCC 1, 358, 1700). Christ calls the faithful to the perfection of holiness (CCC 825). The vocation of the laity consists in seeking the Kingdom of God by engaging in temporal affairs and directing them according to God's will (CCC 898). Priestly and religious vocations are dedicated to the service of the Church as the universal sacrament of salvation (CCC cf. 873; 931).
