## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends,

This Pastor's Message is focused on extending the invitation to attend the Holy Mass of the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart on Friday, June 7th at Sacred Heart Church and celebrating the 350th Anniversary of Apparitions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque. As mentioned previously, will have several events to help promote this Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus:

- 1.The Novena of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (May 29th -June 6th at 6:30 PM)
- 2.The Solemn Procession (4:30PM) and Mass of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (June 7th at 5:30 PM)
- 3.And the Narration of the Apparitions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque (July 2 and 5th)

The Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a very popular devotion, not merely by popular

devotion because of popular interest but a popular devotion by means of recognizing its fruitful effects in the soul of those who practice it. Those who recognize its effects they themselves become promoters of the devotion. What a beautiful occasion that God is giving us now to discover and deepen this devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Therefore, I encourage you to make an extra effort to attend some of these devotional days, especially if you are a member of Sacred Heart Church.

His Excellency, Bishop Daniel Miehm has also decreed that there be a plenary indulgence for those who; (1) Attend Holy Mass and Receive Communion at one of the Sacred Heart Church on the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus (either on June 7th 2024 or June 27th 2025), (2) make a sacramental confession with seven days of the Solemnity Mass (we have confessions on June 7th from 9AM-4:30 PM), (3) and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father. **Reminder:** A plenary indulgence is a grace granted by the Catholic Church through the merits of Jesus Christ to remove the temporal punishment due to sin. This Indulgence can either be applied to ourselves or to a deceased loved one.

## GOSPEL John 15.26-27; 16.12-15 Sun May 19

Jesus said to the disciples: "When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who comes from the Father, he will testify on my behalf. You also are to testify because you have been with me from the beginning.

"I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now.
