Dear Friends,

My name is Fr. Gaston Giacinti. I am a religious priest belonging to the Order of the Institute of the Incarnate Word. I am the second of eight siblings, three of whom have pursued a vocation to the priesthood, while two have become nuns. My family below, and I am #2.



Let me share with you a tittle about my religious life. I entered the Minor Seminary in Argentina on March 1997 when I was 16 years old. In 1999, I did my novitiate and subsequently commenced my studies at the Major Seminary. I spent a period of two years at our IVE Seminary in the USA (2000-2002) and the remainder of my studies back in Argentina. During my formation in the United States, I had the opportunity to visit Canada twice in 2001and then again in 2002 for World Youth Day.

I was ordained to the priesthood on December 3, 2005. Subsequently I spent about 15 year serving in the USA:

• Jan. 2006 to Oct. 2007, Archdiocese of Washington.

• Oct. 2007 to Jul. 2010, Diocese of Brooklyn, NY.

• Jul. 2010 to Sept. 2021, Diocese of Dallas, Texas. and lastly the last three years from Nov. 2021 to Aug. 2024, I studied in Rome and served in the Diocese of Latina-Terracina-Sezze-Priverno.

I am very happy to be able to come to work in Peterborough. In these first few days I have seen that you are a joyful and faith-filled community. I hope and I entrust myself to your prayers, that with the grace of God and the Blessed Virgin, I may be able to serve you faithfully. GOSPEL John 6.41-51 of Sunday August 11

Jesus said to the people: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats of this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh."

The people then disputed among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?"

So Jesus said to them, "Very truly, I tell you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you.
