As we journey through the season of Advent, the figure of Mary shines even more brightly. Her “yes” to the Angel Gabriel paved the way for the coming (advent) of Jesus, our Savior. This week, we have the joy of celebrating her through three beautiful Marian feasts:

- 1- The Immaculate Conception** (Dec. 8, observed on Dec. 9): Mary was conceived without sin, prepared by God to be the pure vessel who would give Jesus her own flesh and bones, becoming the Mother of God.
- 2- Our Lady of Loreto** (Dec. 10): This feast commemorates the “Translation of the Holy House of

GOSPEL Luke 3.1-6 of Sunday Dec 8

In the fifteenth year of the reign of Emperor Tiberius, when Pontius Pilate was governor of Judea, and Herod was ruler of Galilee, and his brother Philip ruler of the region of Ituraea and Trachonitis, and Lysanias ruler of Abilene, during the high priesthood of Annas and Caiaphas, the word of God came to John son of Zechariah in the wilderness.

He went into all the region around the Jordan, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, as it is written in the book of the words of the Prophet Isaiah, “The voice of one crying out in the wilderness: ‘Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight. Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be made low, and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough ways made smooth; and all flesh shall see the salvation of God.’”
