## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,  
As we prepare to enter the holy season of Lent, the Gospel this Sunday invites us to reflect on the condition of our hearts. In Luke 6:39-45, Jesus teaches us using vivid images—a blind person

leading another blind person, a disciple becoming like his teacher, and a tree known by its fruit.

One of the most challenging parts of this passage is Jesus’ call to remove the wooden beam from our own eye before noticing the splinter in our brother’s eye. How often do we criticize others while ignoring our own faults? True discipleship requires humility—an openness to recognize our weaknesses and seek God’s grace for transformation.

Jesus also reminds us that “from the fullness of the heart, the mouth speaks.” Our words and actions reveal what is within us. If our hearts are filled with resentment, pride, or selfishness, that will inevitably show in how we treat others. But if we allow God to purify our hearts through prayer, confession, and acts of charity, then we will bear good fruit—words that uplift, deeds that serve, and a witness that draws others closer to Christ.

As we approach Lent, let us take this Gospel to heart. Let us ask the Lord to open our eyes to our own need for conversion. May our words and actions reflect the love of Christ, and may we strive to be “good trees” that bear abundant fruit for His glory.

-All Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of ‘abstinence from meat’ from age 14 onwards.

Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until 59 (except in case of illness).
