PASTOR’S MESSAGE

Dear Parish Family,  
This weekend, with great joy and thanksgiving, we celebrate a most beautiful moment in the life of our parish: the First Holy Communion of our children. These young members of our community, clothed in innocence and radiant with faith, are receiving Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament for the very first time. What a sacred and powerful gift! As Our Lord said,

“Let the children come to me, and do not prevent them; for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to such as these” (Matthew 19:14). The Eucharist is the source and summit of our Christian life. In Holy Communion, we are united with Christ Himself—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Let us pray that this first encounter will be the beginning of a lifelong friendship with Jesus, nourished at the altar and lived out in daily life.  
In this joyful Easter season, we also reflect on how the Eucharist is intimately tied to our future hope. Jesus tells us: “Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day” (John 6:54). The Eucharist is not only nourishment for the journey but also a pledge of our future resurrection - because we receive the flesh of the One who has already undergone death, defeated it and risen in glory. This is why St. Ignatius of Antioch, one of the earliest Church Fathers, referred to the Eucharist as ‘the medicine of immortality, the antidote for death’. Let us pray for these children receiving First Communion and for our own union with Christ. Fr. Gaston Giacinti.

GOSPEL John 14.23-29 of Sunday May 25

Jesus said to his disciples: “Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. Whoever does not love me does not keep my words; and the word that you hear is not mine, but is from the Father who sent me.  
“I have said these things to you while I am still with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you.  
“Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid.  
“You heard me say to you, ‘I am going away, and I am coming to you.’ If you loved me, you would rejoice that I am going to the Father, because the Father is greater than I. And now I have told you this before it occurs, so that when it does occur, you may believe.”
