PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,
Today we celebrate the feast of two pillars of the Church: St. Peter and St. Paul. St. Peter was crucified upside down on Vatican Hill in Rome. St. Paul was

beheaded outside the walls of Rome. St. Peter - the Rock upon which Jesus built His Church.
St. Paul - the tireless missionary who brought God's Word to the whole world. To Simon, son of Jonah, Jesus said: *"You are Peter, and upon this Peter (rock) I will build My Church"* Jesus changes Simon's name to Peter because a rock gives solidity to the foundation. Moreover, He doesn't say "a church," but *"My Church"* - "my" is a possessive adjective, which indicates that the church of Jesus, Who is the Son of God, is built on Peter, the first Pope. Then, Jesus confers upon Peter strength, authority, and power through three profound metaphors:
1- *"the gates of Hell shall not prevail against it"* The Gates symbolizes "strength";
2- *"I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven"* The Keys symbolizes "authority";
3- and finally *"Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven"* Binding and loosing symbolizes "power".

Together, Peter and Paul embody what we profess in the Nicene Creed: *"I believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church."* The Church is apostolic because it is built on the foundation of the Apostles. To say the Church is apostolic means that it can be traced a lineage back to the Apostles. It also means for us to be faithful to their teaching, continuing their mission, and being willing to offer our lives - as they did - for the sake of Christ and His Church.

May our Blessed Mother, together with St. Peter and St. Paul, obtain for our Pope, our Bishop, our priests, and all the faithful the strength to remain steadfast in our Catholic faith.

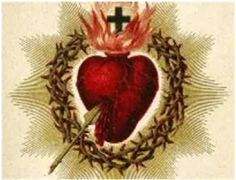
Pope Leo XIV's Prayer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus (released June 2025)
